This year is the year for changes and the CAM chapter is starting it off with an all new Mo-Power Madness car show May 18th at Naperville North High School. So what's new about that? This year instead of having 30 classes with 3 trophies in each class, we are going to have 3 classes with 30 trophies, more or less, in each class. The class with the most entrees will get the most trophies. We have heard the complaints about some classes only having 3 cars in them, and they all get a trophy. Some have complained there are so many cars in some classes, they should have more than 3 trophies. So here is the idea for this year and we think this should make for a terrific show.

First off we will be parking all the vehicles in 3 groups, so if you and your friends have cars that are different, but still fit in the same class, you can park together, if you arrive together, sorry no holding spots. Second, the trophies will be distributed into the 3 classes according to the number of vehicles in each class. The 3 classes will be: Modern, Modified & Stock. Modern will be all vehicles 1976 - 2008. Modified will be all vehicles up to 1975 that have been modified from stock. And Stock is for all vehicles up to 1975 that are stock. There will also be 3 extra "Best in Class" trophies, 1 in each class for the vehicle with the most votes in their class. This means for the first time TRUCKS will compete against CARS, FWD against RWD, CONVERTIBLES against STATION WAGONS and A-BODY cars will take on the WINGED cars. The combinations are endless and should make for a very interesting show. There might not be a solid row of the same type car anywhere on the field, and that will make it a park like atmosphere. Everybody has an equal chance of winning this way. So get out your wax, clean your interior and let's make this our best show ever.
